

How to Get a Patient Referral

If your primary care provider has mentioned that you may need a specialist or more advanced care, you can turn to the experienced medical professionals at Henry Community Health. We offer a wide range of specialties at multiple locations. But first, your physician will need to provide a referral.

Referrals help multiple medical professionals coordinate your care and ensure that everything is in place for insurance purposes. We want to make sure this process is as stress-free as possible, so follow these simple steps to start the referral process. Most of the process will be completed by the referring physician, so you as a patient can leave it to us to help you along the way.

1 STEP ONE

Direct your referring physician to the Referral page on the Henry Community Health website:

2 STEP TWO

Ask your physician to download the correct referral form. There is one General Referral Form that covers most of our practices. If you are in need of spine and pain services, select the Interventional Spine and Pain Referral Form.



3 STEP THREE

Your physician will fill out a simple one-page form with additional instructions on what medical records and other reference materials to send with the completed form.



4 STEP FOUR

Your physician will fax the form to the correct practice. The fax numbers are conveniently included on both referral forms.



5 STEP FIVE

Wait for a member of the HCH team to call you to schedule an appointment.



That's it! Now your team is set to coordinate your care and guide you through the next steps of your medical journey.

Fun fact: Did you know that some specialties DO NOT require a referral? Check with your primary care provider for specialties where no referral is required!
